The Right Reverend Kevin Pearson [will become the 15th Bishop of the United Diocese](#) of Glasgow and Galloway on the 1 July 2020.



The original plans to welcome Bishop Kevin to the Diocese with a service at St Mary's Cathedral on the 4 July had to be postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent lockdown.

However, by 1 July, and in lieu of the planned service, all members of the College of Bishops will have signed the Deed which fulfils Canon Law to make Bishop Kevin the Bishop of Glasgow and Galloway.

Our diocesan celebration will take place on digital channels over the next weeks. The time for a welcome gathering will, eventually, follow.
